The fruits of Capsicum frutescens comply with the following conditions: (i). they have been produced in a site(s) of production approved by the national plant protection organisation of Uganda, (ii). they have been subjected to an effective systems approach in accordance with the measures specified in ISPM14 or an effective stand-alone post-harvest treatment to ensure freedom from Thaumatotibia leucotreta (Meyrick), and (iii). prior to export, they have been subjected to official inspections for the presence of Thaumatotibia leucotreta (Meyrick), with an intensity to enable at least the detection of a 2% level of infestation, with a level of confidence of 95% in accordance with the measures specified in ISPM31 and including destructive sampling in case of symptoms. 2. The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 95d of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The fruits of Capsicum frutescens originate in areas other than those referred to in points (a) and (b), comply with point (c)(i) - (iv) and have been subjected to an effective treatment to ensure freedom from Spodoptera frugiperda (Smith). 3.
