ADDITIONAL DECLARATION

The consignment was inspected and found free from any quarantine pest .

1. The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 94d of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The fruits of Capsicum annuum comply with the following conditions: (i) they have been produced in a site(s) of production approved by the national plant protection organisation of Uganda, (ii) they have been subjected to an effective systems approach in accordance with the measures specified in ISPM14 or an effective stand-alone post-harvest treatment to ensure freedom from Thaumatomotibia leucotreta (Meyrick), and (iii) prior to export, they have been subjected to official inspections for the presence of Thaumatomotibia leucotreta (Meyrick), with an intensity to enable at least the detection of a 2% level of infestation, with a level of confidence of 95% in accordance with the measures specified in ISPM31 and including destructive sampling in case of symptoms.

2. The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 101c of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The fruits of Capsicum annuum comply with the following conditions: (i) that they originate in a place of production established by the national plant protection organisation of Uganda in accordance with ISPM10 as a place of production that is free from Neoleucinodes elegantalis (Guenée), and (ii) that they are free from that pest as shown from official inspections carried out in the place of production at appropriate times during the growing season, which included an examination on representative samples of fruit, and (iii) which includes information on traceability

3. The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 95d of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The fruits of Capsicum annuum originate in areas other than those referred to in points (a) and (b), comply with point (c)(i) - (iv) and have been subjected to an effective treatment to ensure freedom from Spodoptera frugiperda (Smith).

4. The consignment complies with Option (d) schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, under point 102B of the retained Great Britain's Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation (2019/2072): the fruits Capsicum annuum have been subjected to an effective systems approach to ensure freedom from Bactrocera latifrons (Hendel).
