The fruits of Momordica charantia originate in an area established by the national plant protection organization of Uganda in accordance with ISPM4 as an area that is free from Thrips palmi Karny.

The fruits of Capsicum frutescens comply with the following conditions: (i). they have been produced in a site(s) of production approved by the national plant protection organisation of Uganda, (ii). they have been subjected to an effective systems approach in accordance with the measures specified in ISPM14 or an effective stand-alone post-harvest treatment to ensure freedom from Thaumetobia leucotreta (Meyrick), and (iii). prior to export, they have been subjected to official inspections for the presence of Thaumetobia leucotreta (Meyrick), with an intensity to enable at least the detection of a 2% level of infestation, with a level of confidence of 95% in accordance with the measures specified in ISPM31 and including destructive sampling in case of symptoms. 2. The consignment complies with schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, Point 95d of the Great Britain's Phytosanitary Regulation (2019/2072). The fruits of Capsicum frutescens originate in areas other than those referred to in points (a) and (b), comply with point (c)(i) - (iv) and have been subjected to an effective treatment to ensure freedom from Spodoptera frugiperda (Smith). 3. The consignment complies with Option (d) schedule 7 Annex 7 Part A, under point 102B of the retained Great Britain's Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation (2019/2072): the fruits Capsicum frutescens have been subjected to an effective systems approach to ensure freedom from Bactrocera latifrons (Hendel).
